ABOUT SEVILLE

Spain's fourth largest city (700,000 residents) and the capital of Andalusia, Seville is a city rich in history, cultural traditions and art. Its Moorish palaces, narrow cobblestone streets and beautiful gardens remind students at every turn of its 2000 year old existence. Further, its lively street life, year-round Mediterranean climate, cultural opportunities, and friendly locals are what continue to fascinate and allure both natives and visitors worldwide.

PABLO DE OLAVIDE UNIVERSITY IN SEVILLE

UPO, founded in 1997, is one of Spain's youngest, most dynamic, and smallest public universities with just over 9000 students. It is located on a beautiful 345 acre campus less than 5 miles from Seville's city center and accessible by both public bus/metro. The campus contains a gym, indoor courts, and an outdoor running track all available for student use. The university library has numerous computer stations with internet access, as well as wireless internet for students that want to bring their own laptops.

- Open to beginning, intermediate, advanced and superior levels of Spanish students.
- Minimum 2.90 GPA to enter the program.
- 15 semester credits.
- Volunteer work in Seville and a complementary service-learning seminar taught by MundoLengua professors (extra credit offered).
- Unique History of Seville class and complementary visits as part of the course taught by MundoLengua professors (extra credit offered).
- Housing in local host families supervised by MundoLengua. All meals included.
- On-site academic supervision by MundoLengua.
- Excursion to Morocco (2 days) and Cadiz (1 day).

PROGRAMS IN CADIZ

ABOUT CADIZ

Cadiz, population 130,000, was founded by the Phoenicians approximately 1,100 years before Christ, and holds the distinction of being the oldest city in western Europe. Cadiz is surrounded by the sea on three sides. Modern day Cadiz is not overwhelmed by American students and has managed to preserve more of an authentic Spanish flavour.

UNIVERSITY OF CADIZ

The University of Cadiz traditionally belonged to the University of Western Andalusia, centralized within the Rectorado of Seville. It gained its independence and became the University of Cádiz in the early 1980s. The University has been welcoming foreign students for almost 50 years. Located in the center of the city, students will enjoy the feel of this modern campus, which nonetheless retains the old world charm of this fascinating city.

- This is a program for superior level Spanish speakers.
- Classes are taught in Spanish.
- Students enroll with Spanish students.
- Housing in local host families. All meals included.
- Excursion to Morocco (2 days) and Seville (1 day).
